

ORDINANCE NO. 1631

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FOREST, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I. The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to transfer the following money within the General Fund: \$3,147.00 from Account No. 101.704.52502 (Cap. Improv. Equip.) to Account No. 101.704.52501 (Cap. Improv.); \$119.50 from Account No. 101.102.52421 (Misc. Expense) to Account No. 101.102.52371 (Insurance); \$200.00 from Account No. 101.102.52421 (Misc. Expense) to Account No. 101.102.52422 (Pager Repair); \$20.00 from Account No. 101.203.52341 (Mandatory D/A Testing) to Account No. 101.202.52341 (Pmt. to County Health Board).

SECTION II. The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to transfer the following money within the Street Construction Fund: \$500.00 from Account No. 201.602.52442 (Misc. Expense) to Account No. 201.602.52442 (Street Rep. and Maint.).

SECTION III. The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to transfer the following money within the Park and Recreation Fund: \$350.00 from Account No. 204.312.52112 (Pers. Serv. Lifeguards) to Account No. 204.312.52111 (Pers. Serv. Pool Mgr.); \$4,000.00 from Account No. 204.312.52112 (Pers. Serv. Lifeguards) to Account No. 204.311.52112 (Pers. Serv.).

SECTION IV. The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to transfer the following money within the Sewer Fund: \$3,500.00 from Account No. 602.503.52111 (Pers. Serv. Pumping) to Account No. 602.503.52312 (Utilities); \$500.00 from Account No. 602.503.52111 (Pers. Serv. Pumping) to Account No. 602.505.52421 (Misc. Exp. Lagoons).

SECTION V. The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to transfer the following money within the Solid Waste Fund: \$2,022.00 from Account No. 610.501.52302 (Landfill) to Account No. 610.501.52301 (Lease Agreement); \$150.00 from Account No. 610.508.52432 (Gasoline) to Account No. 610.501.52422 (Misc. Expense).

SECTION VI. This ordinance shall be an emergency measure, the particular emergency being the immediate need to meet the financial obligations of the Village. Therefore, for the immediate and best protection of the public peace, health, and safety, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
