

ORDINANCE NO. 1633

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND SELL PERSONAL PROPERTY NOT NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FOREST, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and sell to the highest and best bidder the 1983 Ford 800 cab-over-chassis fire truck, which is not needed for municipal purposes. The advertisement shall state that the Village reserves the right to reject any and all bids submitted.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be an emergency measure, the particular emergency being the immediate need to sell the truck prior to the winter season, thus preventing mechanical damage to the truck which, due to space limitations, will be parked out-of-doors. Therefore, for the immediate and best protection of the public peace, health, and safety, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
