

ORDINANCE NO. 1682

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PAY CLASSIFICATIONS AND WAGE SCHEDULES FOR THE VILLAGE OF FOREST AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FOREST, HARDIN COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I. Pay Classifications and Wage Schedules. The following pay classifications and wage schedules for Village employees are established effective January 1, 2005.

SECTION II. A full-time Village employee who has or obtains a Class I or Class II Water License shall receive additional compensation at the rate of \$1.00 per hour per license. A full-time Village employee who has or obtains a Class I Wastewater license shall receive additional compensation at the rate of \$1.00 per hour.

SECTION III. Bonds. Bonds shall be held in the following minimum amounts by the following officials.

1. The Mayor shall hold bond in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) to be paid from the General Fund.
2. The Clerk-Treasurer shall hold bond in the amount of Five Thousand (\$5000.00) to be paid from the General Fund.
3. The Tax Administrator shall hold bond in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3000.00) to be paid from the General Fund.
4. The Village Administrator shall hold bond in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) to be paid from the General Fund.
5. The Park and Recreation Director and Swimming Pool Manager shall each hold bond in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) to be paid from the Park Fund.
6. The Water Plant Supervisor shall hold bond in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) to be paid from the Water and Sewer Fund.
7. The Chief of Police shall hold bond in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) to be paid from the General Fund.

SECTION IV. Payment of Employee Compensation. Employee compensation shall be paid from the fund or account of the department for which the employee's work is performed.

SECTION V. This ordinance shall be an emergency measure, the particular emergency being the immediate need to provide just and adequate compensation to employees of the Village. Therefore, for the immediate and best protection of the public peace, health, and safety, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
